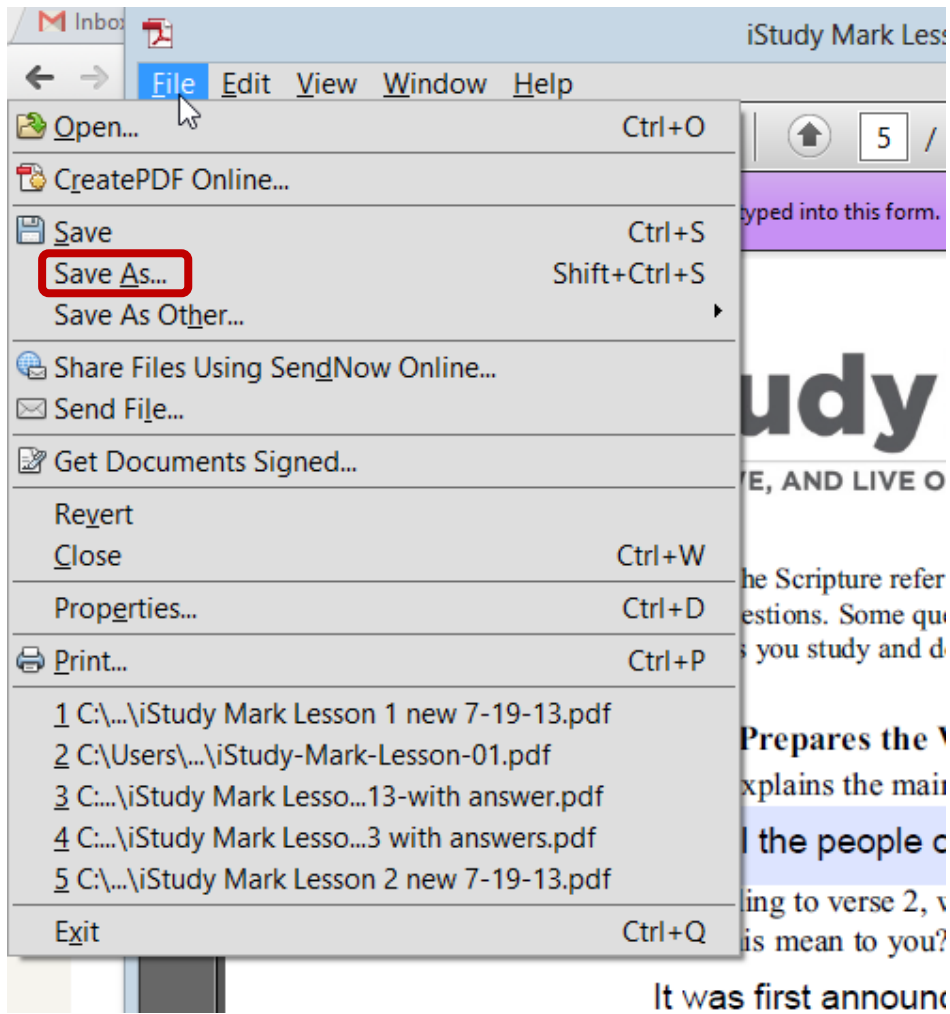

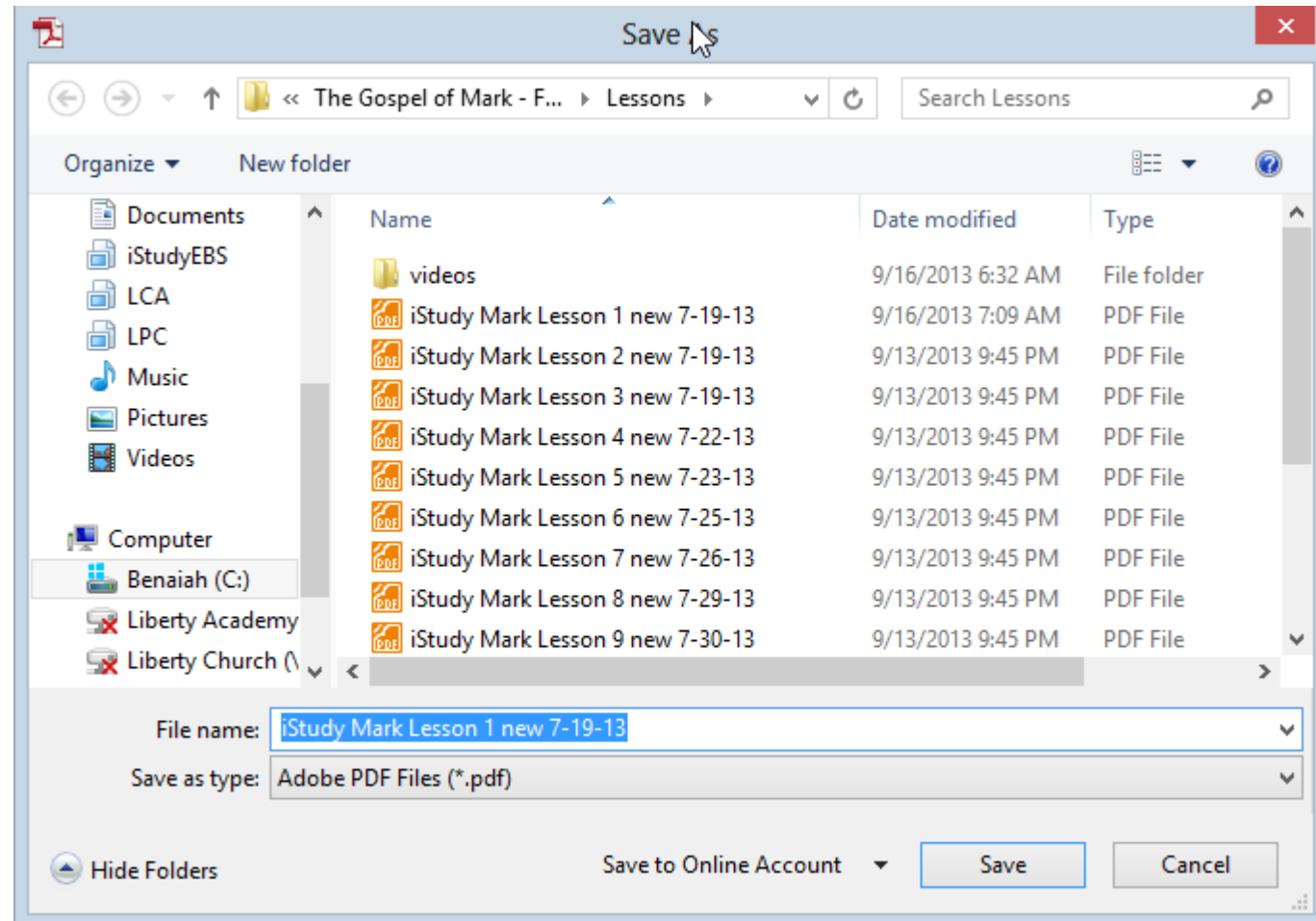
**FIRST DAY: John Prepares the Way (Mark 1:1- 8)**

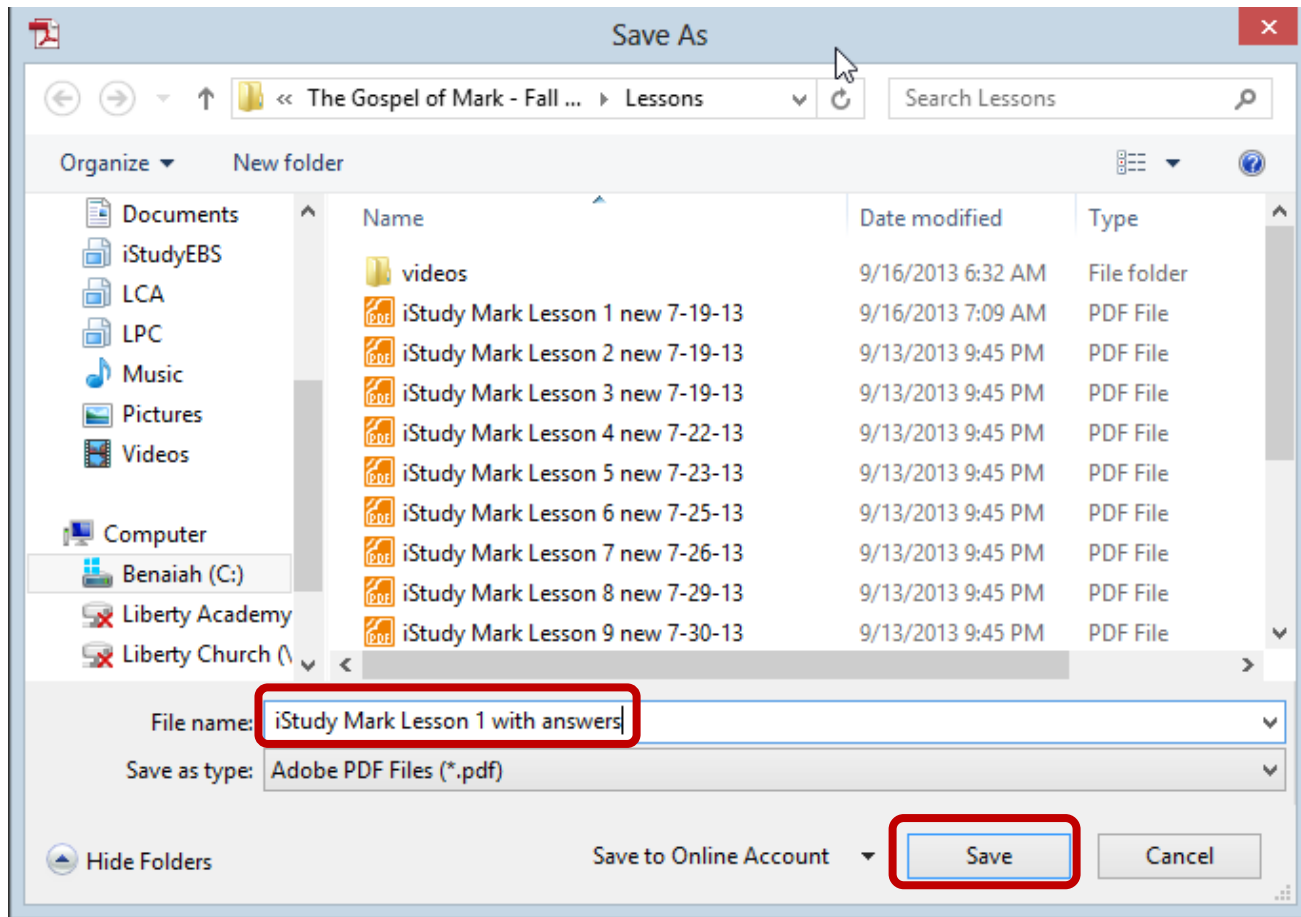
1. Mark explains the main purpose of his book in his very first sentence. What is it?

Once you've done answering the questions for the day, click on **File > Save As...** (refer to image on the left)

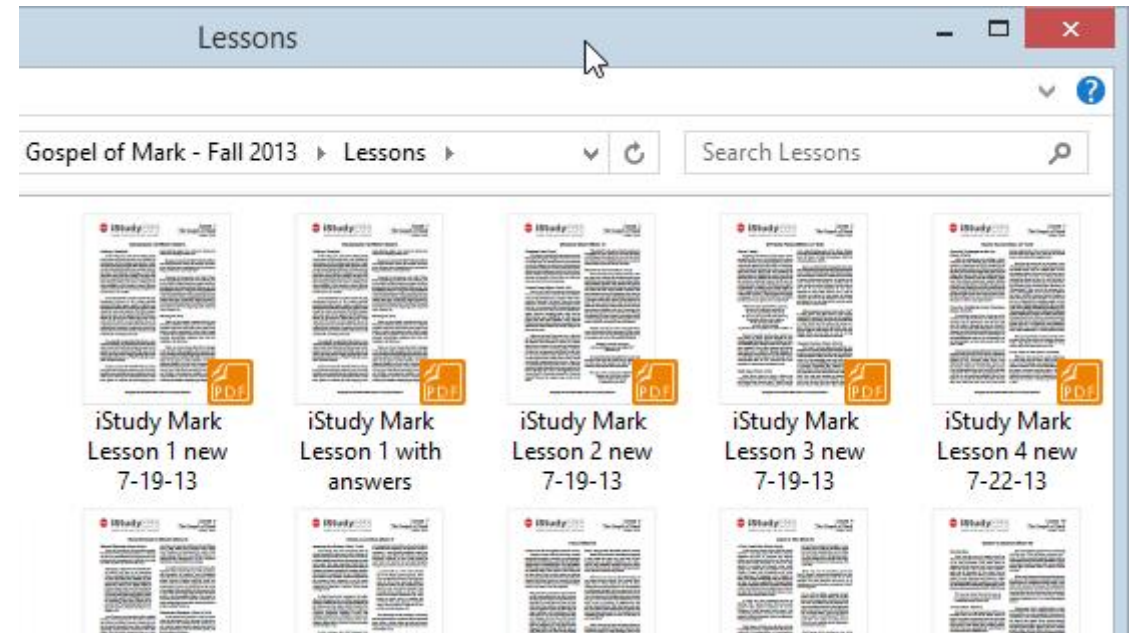
A dialogue box will appear asking you where to save and the file name of the file (refer to image below).





Navigate to the folder where you want to save your file.. It is preferable to use a file name that is descriptive so you know which file you have answers. Click on Save once your finished.

You can check the location of the file where you saved it and you can also open it later to finish answering your lessons.



Once you are ready to answer more, open up the file you just saved. You will see that your answers are saved in your PDF.

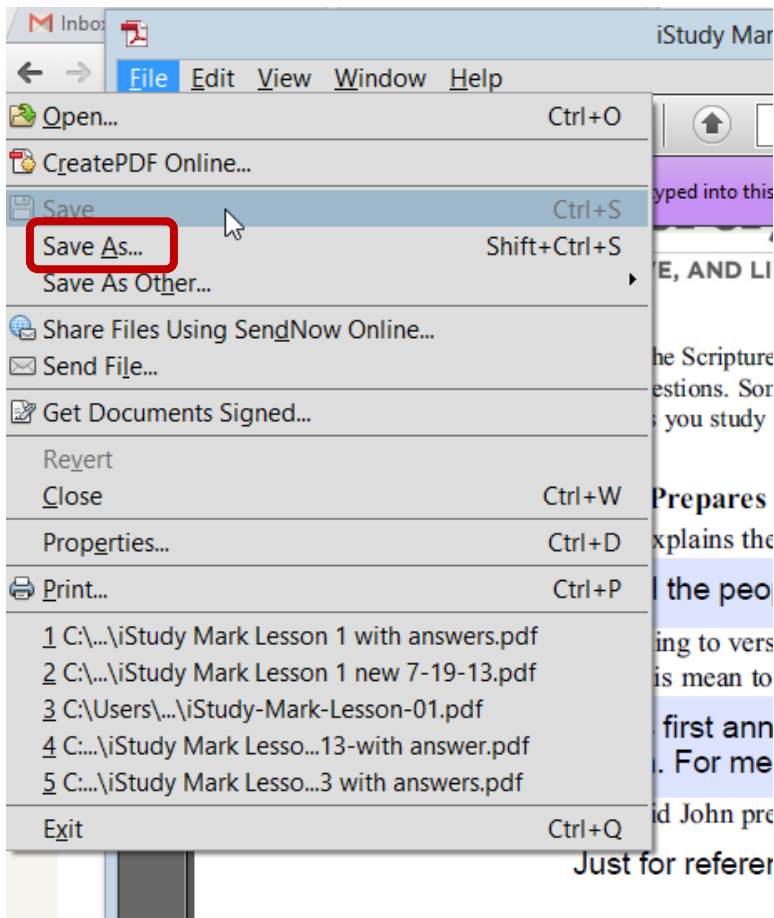
